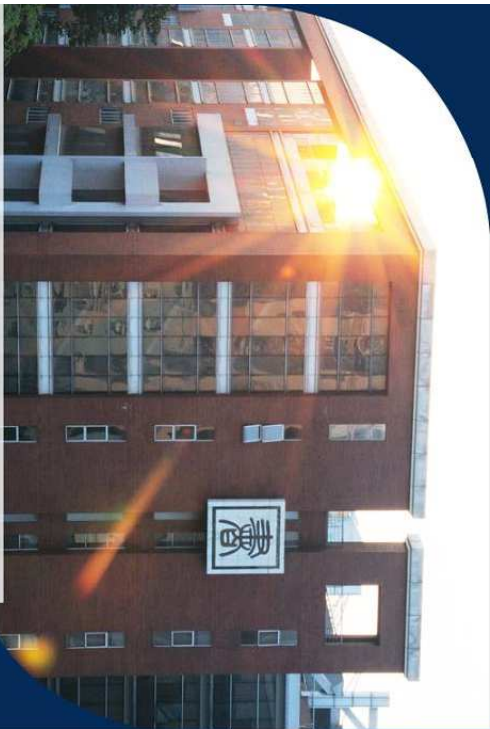

- TOEFL/IBT 550/90, IELTS 6.5 or above required for non-native English speakers or those who have not had a substantial part of their education taught in the English language.

Scholarships

Chinese Government Scholarship

In order to promote the mutual understanding, cooperation and exchanges in politics, economy, culture, education, and trade between China and other countries, the Chinese government has set up a series of scholarship programs to sponsor international students, teachers and scholars to study and research in Chinese universities.

- Applicants can apply for the “**Chinese Government Scholarship**” (including tuition and accommodation fees, and a monthly living allowance of CNY1,700). For details please contact the China Studies Program Office.

Excellent Student Scholarship

- **Self-sponsored students** (those who are not supported by Chinese Government Scholarship) can apply for the university's “China Studies Program Scholarship” amounting to a maximum of **CNY10,000**.
