2、项目简介

从2011年起, 我院每年选派学生赴境外大学交换学习, 交换学生的国际旅费、生活费、膳宿费自理。所有交换生须缴纳暨南大学的学费。交换生在对方取得的课程学分由我校按照专业人才培养方案相应课程予以认可和转换。该项目的出国交换期为1学期, 学生必须按期返校, 继续学习。

3、学生留学期间的教育管理

- (1) 学生要接受对方学校教育管理, 严格遵守对方国家法律和学校规章制度;
- (2) 学生因病或其他原因需要休学, 返校后按学校有关规定办理;
- (3) 学生因违纪经双方教育无效, 返校后按学校有关规定办理。

4、学籍管理及学分转换

5、未尽事宜，参照《暨南大学交换学生手册》，由国际学院负责解释。

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS	English or German B2
ACCOMMODATION	We have a limited number of rooms in the dormitories. The rooms are assigned to the students based upon availability on a first come first serve basis. The dormitories are mixed and there are no apartments for females only. The rent is between 200 and 300 EUR per month, depending on room size and location. The refundable security deposit is 450 EUR.
HEALTH INSURANCE	It is mandatory to have sufficient health insurance coverage to be enrolled and study at a German university. This means that the international students will have to provide a certificate of health insurance in order to enroll at DHBW Karlsruhe. There are different regulations for European and Non-European students. Further information will be provided by the International Office.

It has to be valid for the whole time period of their stay in Germany. If they come here without a student visa, they will only have a tourist status. Without a student visa it is not possible to attend lectures or to be awarded with credits.</p>




